Motivational Speaker/Former Adoptive Child Les Brown and Poet Nikki Giovanni to Keynote DC Adoption Day

-- More than 30 adoptions will be finalized at the 21st Annual Adoption Day ceremony --

The D.C. Superior Court and the D.C. Child and Family Services Agency will co-host the 21st Annual Adoption Day in Court on Saturday, November 17, 2007. The ceremony is designed to celebrate the joy of adoption and encourage area residents to consider adopting or fostering a child. **Over 200 children in D.C. are in foster care, awaiting adoption.**

Over thirty actual adoptions will be finalized at this year's ceremony and adoption decrees will be signed before the audience, as the children and their new families come forward. Each child will be introduced to the audience by emcee Barbara Harrison, local news anchor. Les Brown -- who was adopted as a child and who is now a prominent motivational speaker – and the celebrated poet and Virginia Tech professor Nikki Giovanni will both give remarks at the event.
