## DC to Celebrate 24th Annual Adoption Day

The Superior Court of the District Columbia and the D.C. Child and Family Services Agency will cohost the 24<sup>th</sup> Annual Adoption Day on Saturday, November 20, 2010. The ceremony is designed to celebrate the joy of adoption and encourage area residents to consider adopting or fostering a child in the District's public child welfare system. Approximately 160 children in D.C. foster care are waiting for adoptive homes.

Over 20 adoptions will be finalized at this year's ceremony and adoption decrees will be signed before the audience, as the children and their new families come forward. The keynote speaker for this year's event will be Debra Lee, Chairman and CEO of BET Networks. Each child will be introduced to the audience by local news anchor Barbara Harrison, the emcee.
