## Registration

## **Deadlines**

Registration begins on **January 25th and ends on February 2<sup>nd</sup>.** The Exam4 software must be downloaded and payment made **no later than** 

January 31<sup>st</sup> to avoid late fees. Registration and payment made on February 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> will incur late fees. No registration or payment will be accepted after February 2, 2018. Only applicants who have registered for laptop testing before the deadline will be permitted to use computers to complete the essay portion of the Bar Exam. Applicants who have not registered, downloaded and paid for the software by the deadline will handwrite the essay portion of the exam.
