The senior judges of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals accept law clerkship applications from law students who have completed two years of study at an accredited law school as well as from law school graduates interested in enhancing their legal experience by participating in an appellate court clerkship. Senior judges serve on divisions of the court with associate judges to decide a broad spectrum of cases before the District of Columbia Court of Appeals. Up to five law clerks are hired each term to assist the various judges in the performance of their duties and responsibilities to the court.

The duties of the senior judge law clerk include: conducting legal research; drafting bench memos; drafting opinions and orders; verifying citations; communicating with the Clerk of the Court regarding case management; working closely with other law clerks to assist the senior judges; and any other administrative duties necessary for the efficient administration of the senior judges' chambers.

Ideal candidates for this position should have excellent law school grades, demonstrated experience and skill in legal research and writing, and a commitment to serving the community. The senior judges seek candidates from diverse backgrounds.

Applications are accepted through October 1st of the year preceding the clerkship term. Applicants should submit a cover letter, resume, law school transcript, writing sample and three letters of reference. If four semesters of grades are not available at the time of the application, applicants must provide an updated transcript to the senior judges on or before October 15th of their final year of law school.
