

Melissa Reinberg is an adjunct professor of law at Georgetown University Law Center where she teaches Negotiation and Mediation. She is also a mediator with D.C. Superior Court's Multi-Door Dispute Resolution Division, where she mediates small claims and family cases, and with the Community Dispute Resolution Center, where she mediates criminal and police misconduct cases. Additionally, Ms. Reinberg is a Negotiation Instructor at Calvary Women's Services. Ms. Reinberg has worked as a mediator with the U.S. Office of Special Counsel. She also previously served as the Legal Director of the Legal Aid Society of the District of Columbia, a staff attorney at the Neighborhood Legal Services Program, and a Prettyman Fellow at Georgetown University Law Center's Juvenile Justice Clinic.
