ORDERED that Petitioner's Motion for Summary Judgment is **granted**, for the reasons stated in Part III-A of Petitioner's Memorandum of Points and Authorities, and it is

FURTHER ORDERED that, pursuant to D.C. Code §47-1005.01(c)(2), 17M's leasehold interest in certain real property that is owned by the District of Columbia Government (identified by the District as Possessory Interest ID# 018208280001 and hereinafter referred to as the "Subject", "Subject Property" or "Property") is exempt from taxation under D.C. Code §47-1005.01(b); and that it is

FURTHER ORDERED that 17M is entitled to a refund for the payment of Possessory Interest Taxes for Tax Years 2008, 2009, 2010 in the amount of \$1,516,505.90, plus interest at the rate of 6% per annum from the November 4, 2010 date of filing of the Petition; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED that 17M is entitled to a refund for the payment of Possessory Interest Taxes for Tax Year 2011 in the amount of \$479,656.64 plus interest at the rate of 6% per annum from the September 29, 2011 date of filing of the Petition.
